If you have booked a sightseeing tour through Tennessee Express Tours and our guide will be on your coach, we will be reporting your visit to the Great Smoky Mountains National Park on our CUA (Commercial Use Authorization) and we have included that cost in your guide service fees.

You are required to have proof on hand of the minimum required insurance as follows should the park service request you to produce it while in the park.

Insurance requirements for your group entering the Great Smoky Mountains:

Commercial Vehicle Insurance – Passenger Transport (bodily injury and property damage)	Minimum per Occurrence Liability Limits*
Up to 6 passengers	\$1,000,000
7 – 15 passengers	\$1,500,000
16 – 25 passengers	\$3,000,000
26+ passengers	\$5,000,000

Commercial auto insurance provides:

1. Liability insurance, which includes coverage for bodily injury, property damage, uninsured motorists, and underinsured motorists;
2. Physical damage insurance, which includes collision insurance; and;
3. Other coverage, which includes medical payments, towing and labor, rental reimbursement, and auto loan coverage

Policies must name the United States of America (National Park Service, Great Smoky Mountains National Park, Commercial Services Office, 107 Park Headquarters Road, Gatlinburg, TN 37738) as additional insured.
